COURT I DO CERTIFY THAT THIS IS A TRUE AN

I, VONDA P. DEW, being a resident of Christian County, Kentucky, over twenty-one years of age, and of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

I. PAYMENT OF DEBTS, FUNERAL EXPENSES, TAXES

I direct payment of all my just and lawful debts and funeral expenses as soon after my death as may be practicable. I direct that all of same be paid out of the residue of my estate, without apportionment. I further direct that all taxes levied against my estate, or against any of my beneficiaries by virtue of receiving property from my estate, or against any other persons by reason of my death, be apportioned among my beneficiaries in proportion to the amount of tax allocable to the bequest or other benefit passing to each beneficiary.

II. DISPOSITION OF PERSONAL EFFECTS BY HANDWRITTEN MEMO

I may leave certain personal effects and items of household furniture and furnishings according to directions left by me in a memorandum, written and dated by my hand and signed by me at the bottom, and left with my will. In the

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absence of such directions, all of same shall be disposed of as part of the residue of my estate.

III. DISPOSITION IF HUSBAND SURVIVES BY SIXTY DAYS

If my husband, William C. Dew, survives me by sixty days, I leave to him all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, outright and free of trust.

IV. DISPOSITION IF HUSBAND FAILS TO SURVIVE BY SIXTY DAYS

sixty days, I leave all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate in equal shares to our two children, provided that if either of our children fails to survive me by sixty days, the deceased child's share shall go to his or her issue per stirpes, but if either of our children fails to survive me by sixty days and leaves no issue then surviving, the deceased child's share shall go to the other of our children, or his or her issue per stirpes. If any assets would otherwise pass to a beneficiary who has not then reached the age of eighteen years, such assets shall be held under the Uniform Transfers to Minors Act by a custodian appointed by the court of proper jurisdiction.

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V. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTOR

I nominate my husband, William C. Dew, as executor of

this will. If he for any reason fails to serve as my executor, I nominate my son, William C. Dew, Jr., as executor in his stead. In either event, my executor shall be allowed to serve without surety, and shall have, in addition to all powers conferred by the law in effect at the execution of this will, the power and authority to consult with such accountants, attorneys, financial advisors and other advisors as my executor may consider helpful; to delegate all or any portion of the responsibilities as executor to such agents as he may appoint; and, further, to appoint another person or entity to serve as administrator in his stead. My executor or administrator shall have full and complete power to sell, transfer and convey both real and personal property without the order or approval of any court or the consent or agreement of any person.
