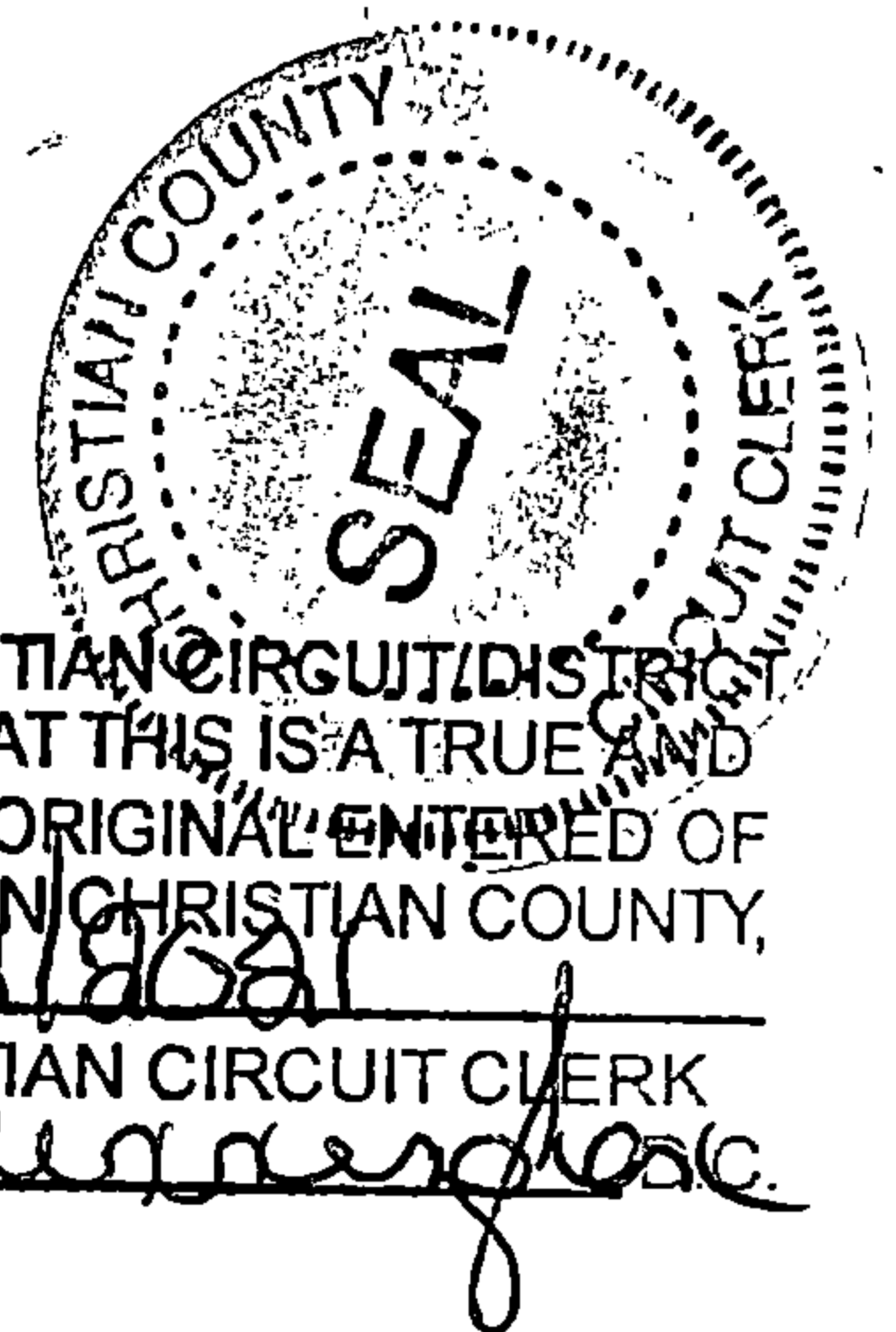

Last Will and Testament

I, Dorothy Jean Webb of Hopkinsville, Kentucky, Christian County, Kentucky, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, governing the disposition of all my property, real or personal, which I may own at the time of my death, and I hereby revoke any and all other former Wills and Codicils by me at any time heretofore made, disposing of such property.

WITNESSETH:

ITEM I. I direct that all of my just debts, my funeral expenses, and the costs of the administration of my estate, including taxes assessed by reason of my death, be paid as soon after my death as is practicable.

I direct my Executor or successor to pay out of my residuary estate as an expense of administration any and all estate taxes, transfer or inheritance taxes, or other death duties which may be levied or assessed against my estate with respect to any and all property required to be included in my gross estate for the purpose of any such taxes without pro ration among the persons interested in my estate or to whom any benefits accrue.

ITEM II. I give, devise and bequeath the following specific bequests of my personal, real and mixed property in Christian County, Kentucky to my husband, Earl Lee Webb, to be had absolutely and in fee simple.

ITEM III. I give, devise and bequeath all the following specific bequest of my personal, real and mixed property in Carlisle County, Ky (Ashington, Ky) and Hickman County, Ky to my husband, Earl Lee Webb, to be his absolutely and in fee simple.

ITEM IV. In the advent that my husband, Earl Lee Webb, should not survive me, then in that advent after my death, I give, devise and bequeath all my personal property to my daughter, Vicki Dianne Webb Champion (only). I give, devise and bequeath all my said property, real and mixed, one half to my daughter, Vicki Dianne Webb Champion and one half to my son, Larry Earl Webb (only) to be theirs absolutely and in fee simple. In the event that either of my children should predecease me and not be living at the time of my death, then I direct that his or her share descend directly to his or her children only.

ITEM V. I make, nominate and appoint my husband, Earl Lee Webb, to be Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and I request that no surety be required upon his bond as such, insofar as the same may be lawfully omitted; and I hereby authorize and empower him to compromise, settle and adjust all debts and claims which may be presented against my estate, or which may be due to my estate; to conduct the sale of my real and/or personal property which may be required to carry out

the intentions and provisions of this instrument, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds and other proper instruments of conveyance to the purchaser or purchasers of said property, which instruments when so executed and delivered by my Executor to be as effective to transfer title to said property the same as if I had executed and delivered the same while living and under no disability. If my Husband, Earl Lee Webb, predeceases me, then I make, nominate and appoint my son, Larry Earl Webb, and my daughter Vicki Dianne Webb (Changier), to be the Co-Executor-Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and I request that no surety be required upon their bond as such, insofar as the same may be lawfully omitted.

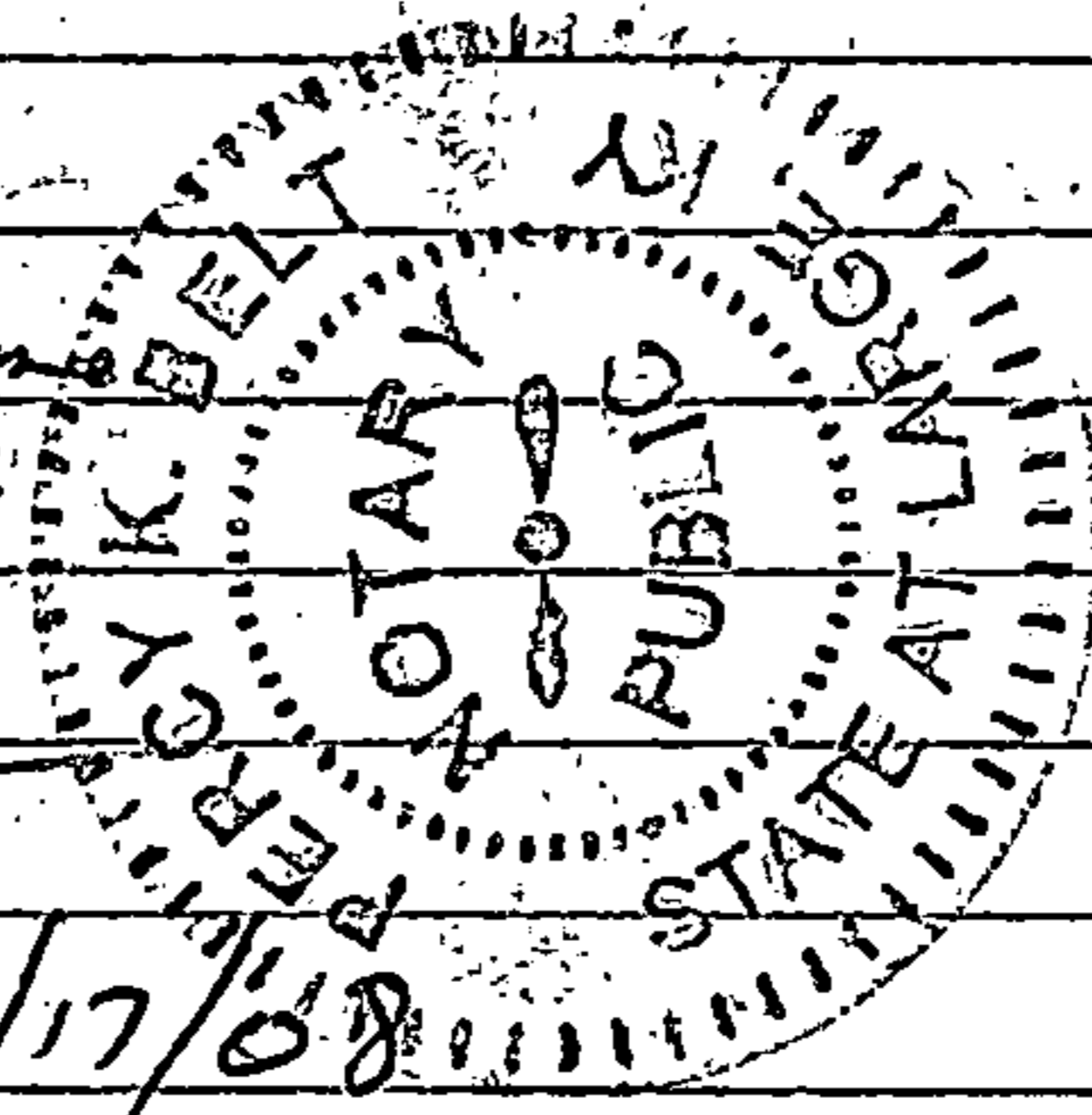
